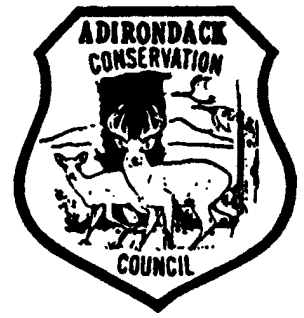

RESOLUTION 2007 – 03

OPPOSE GRANNIS for DEC COMMISSIONER

WHEREAS: Governor Spitzer has nominated Assemblyman Alexander “Pete” Grannis to serve as Commissioner of DEC, and;

WHEREAS: Assemblyman Grannis has an established track record of introducing and supporting animal rights, gun control legislation and opposing trapping, hunting, the 2nd Amendment, snowmobiles, ATV’s, and;

WHEREAS: Grannis has no qualifications, knowledge, training, or education in biology, conservation, wise-use of natural resources, wildlife habitat management, forest management, silviculture, and related fields or in business/organization management and supervision.

THEREFORE; Be It Resolved:

THAT: The Adirondack Conservation Council; representing the anglers, hunters, trappers and outdoor recreationists of the Adirondacks; oppose the appointment of Assemblyman Grannis as Commissioner of DEC, and;

THAT: The Adirondack Conservation Council requests the support of the NYS Conservation Council, Conservation Alliance of New York, all county federations, all sportsmen and conservation clubs, and all sportsmen in opposing this nomination (of Grannis as DEC Commissioner) and work for its/ his defeat, and;

THAT: A fully qualified/ practicing conservationist/ biologist with management experience be appointed as Commissioner of DEC, and;

THAT: Copies of this resolution be sent to each NYS Senator requesting their support in rejecting Grannis and selecting a qualified person as Commissioner of DEC.
